There were no guests or potential members present at this month's Meeting.

2008 Officers

The 2008 Officers were sworn in by Past Detachment Commandant Tim Bertram. Congratulations to all the newly elected Officers. Since the March Meeting Sean Rodriguez has stepped forward and will be taking on the Judge Advocate billet.

Reading of the Minutes

Ken Unertl made a motion to accept the February Minutes as posted in the March Newsletter. Motion seconded by Paul Bollmann and passed.

Paymaster's Report

The Paymaster distributed the current financial statement and went over the past month's transactions. He noted that two Certificates of Deposit had been renewed at 3% for seven month terms. Crossroads Design had turned in a bill for \$190 for digitizing the Marine Corps logo for the red Det. winter jackets in 2006. Don Erdman inquired if the solid black outline around the EGA on the red jackets was a change to the Marine Corps logo, or if it is something the embroiderer has done. The Paymaster explained that the outline is done to enclose the stitching on the jackets and is not a change to the official Eagle, Globe, an Anchor used by the Marine Corps. With no other questions or comments Jim Ramage made a motion to accept the Paymasters Report. Motion seconded by Paul Link and passed.

Correspondence Received/Delivered

The Adjutant has sent Doug Duffin's death notice to the Dept. of WI Chaplain. A Thank You note was received from the Moericke family for the sympathy card the Detachment sent them. The Department of Wisconsin Marine Corps League Scholarship Applications are due by April 10th. Anyone should contact the KetMorDet Adjutant. The Adjutant received a "hit" off the KetMorDet website from a possible new Member. This info was passed to the Jr Vice Commandant (Det. Membership Officer) for follow up.

Report of Standing Committees

Honor Guard: Don Erdman stated that an Honor Guard detail has been requested for April 25th for a Marine Corps Veteran at Washington County Memorial Park. More info to follow. Those interested in participating should contact John Stern, or Don Erdman.

Flag History Presentation Team: The Team will conduct a FHP for the Daughters of the American Revolution at the Wisconsin Club in Milwaukee on April 4th. This is a very prestigious group and facility and will be a highlight event for the FHPTeam. Additional dates are being scheduled and will be announced later. Members should make their local schools, scout units, nursing homes and civic groups, etc. aware of this patriotic function that is provided free of charge by KetMorDet. A month's lead time is needed to set up a FHP. We often get requests at the last minute and this should be avoided. About half of the long sleeve shirts have been received so far and the FHP Team and Honor/Color Guard members will try them on for fit following the regular April Meeting.

PAO: Danny O'Toole received a phone call from Phillips Funeral Home in response to the batch email he sent out reminding local funeral homes that KetMorDet can provide Honor Guard details and ceremonies upon request.

Fundraising: The Detachment seems to struggle filling holiday dates for fundraisers. Accordingly, it was decided to take the second weekend of June, July, August, and September for fundraisers instead of big holiday weekends as done in the past. John Fleischman said that the Brat Fry at the Kewaskum Piggly Wiggly is slated for August 29th. Jim Krudwig inquired about the Brewers home game fundraisers. The Adjutant will send a request to the Brewers organization and see if any dates are still available. Jim Krudwig reminded all that a Member had, at an earlier meeting, brought up the question of which fundraisers proceeds are used to fund the Support the Troops & other charities, uniforms, Det. functions, etc. He requested that the Officers come up with a plan to advise the Members how this will be accomplished.

Newsletter: The Editor asked if any Members had taken and passed the Citizenship test included in the March Newsletter. He has copies of the answers on hand for Members who could not get them on-line to see how they did. Bios are needed on many Members. A retired Marine Master Sergeant, Tom Knoll, who entered the Corps from Milwaukee, is jogging across the US trying to raise \$1,000,000 for: 1) The Wounded Warrior Project (WWP) which was founded on the principle that veterans are our nation's greatest citizens. The WWP seeks to assist those men and women of our armed forces who have been severely injured during the conflicts in Iraq, Afghanistan, and other locations around the world. Many of the injuries are traumatic amputations, gunshot wounds, burns and blast injuries that will retire these brave warriors from military service. 2) Sunshine Foundation which was established in 1976 to answer the dreams of seriously ill, physically challenged and abused children ages 3 - 18 nationwide. To date Sunshine Foundation has answered over 32,000 dreams. 3) Soldier Security Association of America which was formed to provide veterans who live with service related disabilities of a physical or emotional nature the opportunity to receive private financial or in-kind benefits in a variety of areas. Top Knoll is raising money by jogging 30 miles a day, every day until he has gone from San Diego CA to Washington D.C. He can be tracked by logging onto http://www.usathleticevents.org/Charities. Greg Bertling made a motion to donate \$200 dollars in support of Top Knoll's effort. Jim Ramage seconded and motion passed.

The Adjutant showed Marine Corps League Medals available to Members. 


